* Ohio State claims No. 2 seed due to 12-7 head-to-head win versus Indiana; [^] Due to Illinois, Purdue & Iowa tying at 3-5 in regular season play, the tie is broken based on the Tiebreaking Procedures. As all three teams are 1-1 versus one another, the tiebreaker reverts to goal differential which Iowa (8-4 W vs. Purdue, 7-5 L vs. Illinois = +2) wins over Illinois (7-5 W vs. Iowa, 8-7 L vs. Purdue = +1) and Purdue (8-7 W vs. Illinois, 8-4 L vs. Iowa = -3). Once Iowa receives the No. 5 seed, the tiebreaker reverts back to head-to-head between Illinois and Purdue, with Purdue earning the No. 6 seed due to an 8-7 win over Illinois.
