*Due to Ohio State not competing at the Purdue tournament, the division championship is seeded based on winning percentage; * Due to Ohio State and Indiana not playing the same number of games, but both holding .500 regular season winning percentages, the tie is broken based on the differential for all common opponents seeded higher. Since Ohio State lost to both Michigan (13-5 L) and Michigan State (8-5 L), the Buckeyes have a -11 differential. Indiana lost to Michigan (10-9 L, 10-7 L - average differential of -2) and Michigan State (8-7 L) for a total differential of -3, Indiana claims the No. 4 seed.*
