\$ Due to Dayton and Loyola not meeting in the regular season, the goal differential against all common opponents seeded higher (Ohio State, Miami) is used with Dayton (11-7 L vs. OSU, 6-5 L vs. Miami) bettering Loyola (17-7 L vs. Miami, 15-11 L vs. OSU) by a 6-to-14 in goal differential comparison.
