** Since the University of Notre Dame and Grand Valley State University did not play during the regular season in league play, the goal differential against the highest seeded common opponent is used. As Notre Dame holds advantages against both Lindenwood University (14-1 W vs. 10-3 W) and the University of Cincinnati (15-3 W vs. 10-1 W), Notre Dame is the No. 1 seed.; Per the guidelines for breaking ties among teams that did not play each other, the University of Cincinnati claims the No. 3 seed as the team fell to Notre Dame 15-3 for a -12 goal differential, while Lindenwood University lost to Notre Dame 14-1 (-13 goal differential); Saint Louis University claims the No. 5 seed with a -5 goal differential (12-7 L) against Notre Dame compared to a -11 for Illinois State University (14-3 L); % Miami University claims the No. 5 final position due to goal differential. As Miami, Cincinnati and Saint Louis University all defeated one another at the championship, the first tiebreaker is goal differential. Miami (+2), Cincinnati (+1) both had positive differentials while Saint Louis (-3) had the lowest to finish seventh. The tiebreakers revert back to head-to-head with Miami claiming the No. 5 position due to a 7-4 win over Cincinnati.*
