The tournament is not seeded by ability, since there is no equitable means to determine the respective strength of the teams. Too few teams play outside of their division schedules to be able to create an accurate seeding. Match-ups are therefore based upon the 2014 National Collegiate Club Championship results by division.

Due to the creation of several new divisions in 2015, the CWPA Seeding Policy is adjusted to the following:

Seed the top eight division winners and perform a random draw with the Pacific Coast, Mid Atlantic, and Rocky Mountain Divisions for 9th through 11th. Seed the remaining divisions according to their finish, with a random draw performed for the teams tied in finish last year. Seed the remaining divisions according to their finish, with a random draw performed for the teams tied in finish last year. The fourth position is allocated to the Atlantic Division as Duke University won in 2014 from the Mid-Atlantic and they are now part of the Atlantic Division. The Fifth position goes to the Midwest Division as Lindenwood University won the Great Plains Division title in 2014 and are now part of the Midwest Division. The Ninth-to-11th positions are seeded based on a random draw between the Pacific Coast, Rocky Mountain and Mid-Atlantic Divisions. The 12th position goes to the New England Division, while the New York and Heartland Divisions are seeded 13th and 14th based on a random draw. The North Atlantic Division receives the No. 15 seed due to the division not sending a representative to the championship in 2014. The 16th position belongs to the host institution unless Middlebury wins the New England Division title. If Middlebury wins its division title, then the runner-up from the New England Division assumes the No. 16 position.

Teams listed first wear dark caps and are home on the scoreboard. Host team always wears dark caps and is listed first on the scoreboard regardless of seed.
