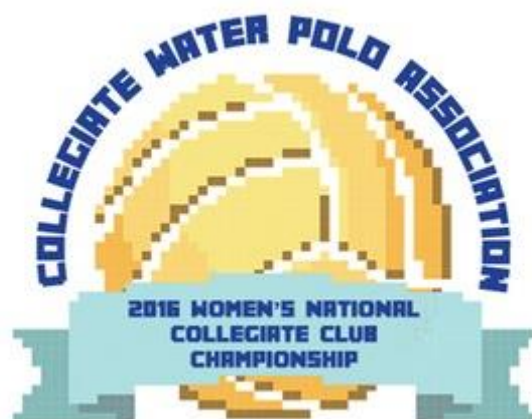

The tournament is not seeded by ability, since there is no equitable means to determine the respective strength of the teams. Too few teams play outside of their division schedules to be able to create an accurate seeding. Match-ups are therefore based upon the 2015 National Collegiate Club Championship results by division. Due to 2015 tournament host/New England Division runner-up Middlebury College finishing 11th, the New England Division receives the No. 11 position for the 2016 event. Position No. 13 is awarded to the North Atlantic Division as the New England Division is seeded at No. 11 due to Middlebury's finish. The No. 14 and 15 positions were awarded based on a random draw between the Texas and Heartland Divisions.

** Due to Yale University electing not to participate in the championship and two Sierra Pacific Division teams set to play in the 1st Round, the No. 13-to-16 positions for the field are adjusted. As No. 1 seed the University of California-Davis and host the University of California-Santa Cruz both belong to the Sierra Pacific Division, the No. 1-vs.-16 meeting between the two teams changes. League policy states that teams from the same division cannot meet in the first round. Due to this, UC-Santa Cruz moves up to the No. 15 seed.*

+Yale University of the North Atlantic Division elected not to participate in the championship. The position assigned to Yale, No. 13, is therefore vacated with the runner-up from the North Atlantic Division (Wellesley College) invited to participate.

To prevent the runner-up from a division being seeded above division champions, the No. 14-to-15 seeds (Texas Division, Heartland Division) move up to No. 13 and 14. Due to UC-Santa Cruz moving up to No. 15 to avoid an all-Sierra Pacific Division first round game, the North Atlantic Division representative's position moves to No. 16.

Teams listed first wear dark caps and are home on the scoreboard. Host team always wears dark caps and is listed first on the scoreboard regardless of seed.
