**** Per the following, the tie for the No. 1 position is broken: "If the won/loss records of two teams are the same, the team that won in their head-to-head competition is the higher seed. If these teams each beat one another, the goal differential in their games is used to break the tie. If the goal differential in their contests against one another is the same, the total of goals scored against each other is used. If the total of goals scored between the teams is equal, the differential for all common opponents seeded higher is used. If no common opponents are seeded higher, the goal differential against the highest seeded common opponent is used." As Cornell best No. 3 seed New York University by a 22-7 final for a +15, and Army beat NYU 11-7 for a +4, Cornell is the No. 1 seed.***

Syracuse failed to appear at its home tournament and is suspended for the remainder of the 2014 and the entirety of the 2015 men's seasons. All games against Syracuse are considered null and are not counted for teams records.
