The meeting opened with a discussion of the schedule. Unfortunately, all of the teams are unable to determine dates until their swim teams finalize their schedules. However, a tentative schedule was determined:

Since Tennessee was not on the call, their interest in participating and potentially hosting is unconfirmed. Additionally, both Alabama and Auburn are on break the last weekend in October, which might present a problem if that is the only date available to host the championship.

Both Alabama and Georgia Tech indicated the possibility of having B teams, and they should be able to confirm by June.

Middlebury has offered to switch to the North Atlantic. With the addition of the University of Connecticut, that will give each division six teams.

The Commissioner reminded everyone that their Participation Agreements must be submitted by their club supervisors before they leave for the summer. In addition, those hosting will need to submit Pool reservation forms. Both items can be found by going to the website and clicking on the Forms tab.
