The meeting opened with a discussion of the schedule. Teams discussed the fact that more clubs were in Colorado so the championship should remain in their state. The Commissioner mentioned that divisions with this geographic disparity set up rotations. Teams agreed to rotate the championship between Utah and Colorado annually and voted 3-2 to have it at Air Force this season.

The schedule was determined to be as follows:

- April 5-6 Air Force

The Commissioner reminded everyone hosting that they will need to submit Pool reservation forms.
